We have had a busy week this week, we have been learning about ourselves. We have been looking in the mirror to see what colour eyes and hair we have, we created our faces for our new wall display. On Monday we were mythical creatures in the hall for PE. Our book of the week was 'What I like about Me', and our song was Head Shoulders Knees and Toes, where we sequenced the pictures in the correct order. Our sound of the week was 'c' and our number was 9. We used our fine motor skills with tweezers and matched colours and counting the little people. We enjoyed practicing some Christmas songs with instruments, and have started decorating our room by making paper chains. I have had a lovely first week back in Pre School, and we are looking forward to the Christmas season!



In year 2 this week, we have started a new maths block of learning all about shape. We have learnt the names of many 2d and 3d shapes. We know how to identify the different shapes by counting their sides and vertices. We have also tried to make the different shapes with peg boards and tried draw them using a ruler.





In year 4 we have been learning how to do different stitches to join fabrics for our DT. We have learnt a running stitch, back stitch and over stitch. We have also investigated how different bags are made and what they are made from.



Year 6 have been working hard this week, they have completed several assessments, revealing the progress they have already made since September.



They have also started to design and make their own websites using Google Sites. They have created a plan for their website and then created a homepage as well as using hyperlinks to link to their sites other pages.

In science they have investigated what happens when the voltage is increased in an electrical circuit. Finally they have written Christmas Cards in French to their Pen Pals in France!
